BTEC 1st Certificate in Public Services

The Public Services course is designed to provide students with the skills required for success within a wide variety of public sector occupations including the Armed Forces, Police, Fire, Prison and Paramedics.

Progression routes: BTEC 1st Diploma in Public Services, employment in Public Services, e.g. Armed Forces, Fire Service, Police, etc.

Catering

City & Guilds Introduction to Food Studies

For those who aspire to be the next Gordon Ramsay, this course will help you on your way, developing your culinary skills as well as learning about hygiene and the safe use of equipment.

Progression routes:

NVQ 1 Food Preparation & Cooking, or Food & Drink Service, NVQ 1 in Quick Service or entry level employment in the service industry.

Childcare

City & Guilds Certificate in Preparation for Employment (Childcare)

This Course aims to develop some basic skills for young people who are interested in a career working with children and has a clear pathway right up to a Foundation Degree.

Progression routes: Introductory Diploma in Health & Social Care, which then leads on to a First Certificate in Children's Care, Learning & Development.

Motor Vehicle

City&Guilds Entry Level 3 in Automotive Vehicle Maintenance - Full/Half day provision

In this course you will learn about cars inside and out. Covering subjects such as identifying different types of engines and understanding the principles of vehicle body design and electrical systems.

Progression routes: NVQ 1 Vehicle Maintenance, NVQ 2 Vehicle Maintenance and Repair, Modern Apprenticeship.

Progression routes: Apprenticeship, Performing Engineering Operations NVQ 2, BTEC National Award in Engineering

OTHER COURSES

Beauty Therapy

City & Guilds Level 1 Certificate in Salon Services - Half day only

This course gives you an introduction to the type of knowledge and understanding required when working in the Beauty Industry and can lead on to a career in beauty salons, leisure centres, spas, holiday complexes, cruise liners, technical demonstrators.

Progression routes:

NVQ Level 2 in Beauty followed by NVQ Level 3 in Beauty.

Art & Design

NCFE Certificate in Creative Craft.

This course is an excellent basis for a career in the creative industries, from graphic design, to Fine Art to Fashion Design and everything in between.

Progression routes:

BTEC Introductory Diploma in Art, Design & Media

Hairdressing

OCR Entry Level Hairdressing - half day provision City & Guilds NVQ Level 1 Certificate

- Full day provision

people? Then hairdressing could be for you.

Progression routes: NVQ 1 & 2 Hairdressing, Apprenticeship in Hairdressing, employment as a junior in a salon.

Construction Carousel

Please contact the college to confirm the qualification

The qualification will consist of an introduction to various construction trades concentrating on Brickwork, Painting & Decorating and Carpentry & Joinery. Pupils must rotate through each trade to gain the qualification. Progression will be to one of the trade routes via Construction Diploma at Level 1, or Apprenticeships via the college or Construction Skills (CITB). Safety wear/boots (PPE) will be provided.

Retail

City & Guilds Preparation for Employment -Retail

If you enjoy working with people then this retail qualification will give you a foundation in customer service.

Progression routes: Apprenticeship

Horticulture

Level 1 Certificate in Horticulture Skills

- Full day only

If you are green fingered, like working outdoors and want to learn more this course would be perfect for you.

Progression routes: NVQ Level 1 in Horticulture

Land Based Studies

(Cockermouth Learning Centre)

NVQ Level 1 in Land Based Operations

(Agriculture) - Full day only

This qualification provides an introduction to a range of land-related occupations, skills and knowledge, with routes available in agriculture and environmental conservation, horticulture, floristry and animal and horse care.

The three routes that will be available at the Lakeland Learning Centre are:

Agriculture • Forestry • Equine

Progression routes: Apprenticeship, National Award or National Certificates at Newton Rigg (University of Cumbria).

Sport & Fitness

NCFE Level 1 Certificate in Exercise Studies - Half day only.

This course isn't just about exercise it is about understanding exercise and developing the skills you require to work in this growing area of popular leisure. You will also have the opportunity to achieve the Junior Sports Leader Award in the first year and the Coaching Sport Award in the second year.

Progression routes: NVQ 1 / 2 Sport and Recreation, Employment within Leisure Industry.
