



What are T Levels?

T Levels are a brand new, 2-year qualification that will give you a head start towards the future you want.

They bring classroom learning and an extended industry placement together on a course designed with businesses and employers.

Who are T Levels for?

T Levels are ideal if you have finished your GCSEs and want the knowledge and experience to get straight into employment, an apprenticeship or higher education.

You'll spend 80% of your time in the classroom and 20% on a 45-day placement with an employer to give you the knowledge and skills companies look for.

T Levels are equivalent to 3 A Levels and you can earn UCAS points as you study, meaning you could go on to university after completing the course.











WORK EXPERIENCE & INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

At Lakes College, we believe that learning shouldn't just be confined to the classroom.

We want our students to have the experience to back up their qualifications, which is why every full-time student completes work experience as part of their course.

Course fees vary depending on the level of qualification you would like to study, along with your personal circumstances...

You may not have to pay tuition fees on certain courses if you meet the criteria below:

- You're aged 16 to 18 years old
- You work and earn less than £16,009 a year

 you could be entitled to a free course if
 you're studying up to a Level 2 qualification
- You're aged 19 to 23, enrolling on a Level 2, Level 3 course and do not already have a full Level 2/Level 3 qualification or higher

Or you receive one of the following:

- Job Seekers' Allowance (JSA)
- Income Support
- Universal Credit
- Council Tax Benefit (single occupancy doesn't apply)
- Financial support for asylum seekers who have been in the UK for six months or more





As part of the course students carry out placements in different hospitals or departments across the NHS in Cumbria.

These placements help many of our students choose which area of the health service they have an interest in for further study. Each student is paired up with a healthcare support and guidance while on placement.

80% of our first cohort of Nurse Cadets students went on to study nursing, a clinical subject, or a health and social care subject at university. The remaining 20% went on to work in a clinical setting.

The UK is entering a new stage in its nuclear history. Worldwide investment in new nuclear is set to hit a staggering £930 billion across the next 20 years, with a number of new reactors planned for the UK alone.




