

Joinery Skills Bootcamp

Course Aim

This 16-week programme is designed to give an introduction to the joinery industry. This pre-employment course will help you develop your practical skills and enhance your knowledge.

The programme will boost your confidence and motivation in a supportive environment. Work focused with advice and information on CV and interview skills, transferable skills, job applications and action planning – we will support you to gain employment or an apprenticeship.

Course Content

The course comprises of theory work and practical sessions in the joinery workshop in the college's state-of-the-art Construction Skill Centre. The course will give learners an introduction to health and safety principles, as well as learning Level 2 Carpentry Skills, 1st and 2nd fix, and structural carcassing.

Schedule

A blend of face to face classes and practical sessions supported by online knowledge session and resources. Commencing on 03 November 2022 from 1:15pm-4:00pm for 16 weeks. Employability classes will also take place throughout the 16 weeks which will include face to face classes and self-study.

Employer Costs

Learner Costs

The training is free if you meet the following criteria:

- Aged over 19 years of age
- Recently unemployed within the last 12 months or looking for work e.g. coming back into the workforce after a career break
- Resident in the UK and legally entitled to work in the UK
- If you are employed, you can also undertake the training free of charge as an individual
